How is the “Green Weekend” recycled tee manufactured?

Step 1: Textile waste of clippings are collected from several pre-consumer venues: new apparel cuttings, upholstery and trim fabric, yarn waste, industrial fibers and tire chord.

Step 2: Clippings are sorted by color and chopped into a fine linty material called “shoddy”.

Step 3: Shoddy is then spun into yarn that is used to produce the tees. The recycled cotton fibers require no new dyeing because they are color blended by using pre-consumer textile clippings.
